As we're starting a new year, let us first wish you all the best for 2018, and report on our 2017 activities and audited accounts.

Work on the ground

We are happy that 93% of children schooled in hospitals passed class in June 2017, thanks to the dedication of our teachers who never let a hospitalized child miss a day of school.

We currently school <u>124 children</u> and employ <u>13 teachers</u> in <u>6 hospitals</u>.

Since inception in 2010, we have schooled 508 children undergoing treatment for life-threatening illnesses.

We welcomed Mrs. Adla Kokoni as our new Hospital Coordinator.

Financial accounts: USD 64k deficit

- Disbursements of \$218k were mostly allocated to pay teachers in hospitals.
 Disbursements have been stable since 2015 as we are present in all hospitals where it is relevant.
- However, fundraising dropped to \$154k (down by \$135k) due to lower donations.
- We consequently incurred a USD 64k deficit.

- **July**: <u>"Pulse 5K &1K"</u>, our 8th edition gathered 1,660 participants in Faqra Club. Our next edition (9th) is on Sunday, August 5, 2018.
- **April**: "Swimathon", in association with the Lebanese International Swimming Academy (LISA), gathered children from various schools to participate in a fun swim fundraising race.
