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Our Story

Myschoolpulse started after Paul Yared (12 year old) left us because of an osteosarcoma (bone cancer).

During his illness, Paul insisted on carrying on with school. That meant getting his teachers to give him private lessons at home and at hospital.

In June 2009, Paul received a stellar grade report. Sadly, his cancer was already out of control, and he passed away in the summer of 2009.



Mireille Nassif, Paul's mother, and Danièle Diab, Paul's cousin, founded Myschoolpulse in June 2010 to help sick children successfully keep up with school.

The Reality

Paul's story is sad.

But Paul's story is inspiring.

250 children are diagnosed with cancerevery year in Lebanon.80% of children heal from cancer.

It is key that those children don't lose one or two years of school while they undergo treatment at hospital.

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Myschoolpulse is a Lebanese non-profit organisation whose mission is to provide seriously ill children support for their education and their wellbeing.

Benefits of Schooling Sick Children

• Educational benefits:

 Help sick children pursue their education uninterrupted to keep up with their peers, attain the next school level and reintegrate mainstream school as smoothly as possible, when they recover.



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• Psychological benefits:

- ✓ Minimize children's feelings of exclusion from normal life while fighting their illness.
- Improve the well-being of children during their medical stay including but not limited to providing psychological support as well art therapy lessons.
- ✓ Provide financial assistance to underprivileged sick children as well as their siblings especially where the sickness put financial pressure on their families.
- ✓ Ensure reasonable financial safety for Myschoolpulse employees.

- Description
- One-on-one tutoring at the child's bed when he/she is undertaking treatment in hospital.
- Since 2020, Myschoolpulse has switched to e-tutoring to ensure the children's safety.
- Group tutoring of sick children in the same or adjacent school levels, in the hospital's school room.
- Professional psychological support to help children live a life as normal as possible during the treatment period. This includes keeping a school focus.
- Art therapy provides support through the arts for mental well-being.
- Individual and group activities, such as computer, logic games, story telling and arts and crafts with an art therapist.

Social Support

 When necessary, Myschoolpulse will extend scholarships to its students and their siblings.

Rationale and Benefits

 Ensure children keep up with their school work when they are in hospital for a long treatment period

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
- Ensure learning continues uninterrupted, in hospital and online

Our Impact

Our 100% Model

- We aim that 100% of donations go to the tutorship of sick children.
- We aim to cover 100% of operational expenses by events revenues (*).
- We report online on our activities and audited accounts.



(*) 100% of operational expenses were covered by the co-founder Mireille Nassif during the first 2.5 years. On a cumulative basis from 2010 to 2020, net fundraising more than covered operating expenses by 109%.


Art Therapy

Art therapy helps children:

- ✓ Express fear and worry.
- ✓ Deal with anger and frustration.

- ✓ Communicate better with parents and siblings.
- ✓ Improve self-confidence and positive self-talk.
- ✓ Find inner strength and nurture it.

Chemotherapy Fund in 2020

Cancer treatment medication (*one-off action post explosion***)**

The 4 August 2020 explosion in Beirut destroyed two main hospitals in which Myschoolpulse operates, interrupting the treatment of 120 children. The blast also destroyed the stockpiles of medicine in St-George Hospital.

In agreement with its top donors, Myschoolpulse immediately pledged USD 100'000 to buy chemotherapy medications, enabling children to continue their treatment one week after the blast.

This initiative was a one-off action in 2020 given the exceptional circumstances Lebanon went through.

Our focus is and will remain our main mission, school in hospitals.

Initiatives beyond 2021

Scaling up operations in Lebanon

- ✓ Expand tutoring in hospitals, if and when required, by hiring more teachers.
- ✓ Expand e-learning in all hospitals and from home while the pandemic lasts.
- ✓ Offer Art Therapy sessions in all hospitals.
- ✓ Expand operations to other hospitals in Lebanon.

A holistic approach

- Improve the well-being of children during their medical stay including but not limited to providing psychological support as well art therapy lessons.
- Provide financial assistance to underprivileged sick children as well as their siblings especially where the sickness put financial pressure on their families. Indeed, education might become the sole long-term victim of a disease.
- ✓ Ensure reasonable financial safety for Myschoolpulse employees.
